# HARDLINE MAC INSTALLATION & ERRATA CARD

Please Read, Very Important!

Thank you for purchasing the Mac version of *Hardline*. The enclosed manual was originally written for the PC version and it will be your main source of gameplay information. However, there are a couple of changes we'd like to tell you about. For the Mac version, please ignore the installation instructions in the existing manual and refer to this errata card.

# MAC SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

(Replaces system requirement information on page 2 in existing manual):

# Required:

68040 processor 8MB Ram 2X speed CD drive 40MB of hard drive space 0/S 7.1 or higher Sound Manager 3.1 (included on the CD)

# Recommended:

Power Mac 601 processor 12MB of Ram 4X speed CD drive 80MB of hard drive space Mac O/S 7.5 or higher Sound Manager 3.1

# INSTALLING HARDLINE

(Replaces installation information on pages 2 and 3 in existing manual):

- 1. Insert the Hardline CD disc one into your CD-ROM drive.
- Double-click on the Hardline icon.
- To install Hardline, drag one of the light, medium or deluxe folder icons onto your hard drive.
- 4. Re-name the copied folder as: Hardline

## PLAYING HARDLINE

- 1. Open the Hardline folder on your hard drive.
- Double-click on the Hardline 68K LIGHT/MEDIUM/DELUXE icon to start.

Note: Power Mac owners should click on the Hardline PPC Light/Medium/Deluxe icon to start.

# GAMEPLAY CONTROL CHANGES

(Changes and adds to command information on page 6 in existing manual and affects gameplay control instructions throughout manual):

increase the speed of the game on slower machines.)

# ADDITIONAL MAC TROUBLE-SHOOTING

### SLOW PROCESSORS

Some Centris and Performa models (68040/68LC040 processors) may experience slower than normal gameplay. In this event, you may want to use the tab key to change the resolution, improving the speed of the game.

# **QUADRA 800 PROBLEMS**

The game may experience problems running on a Quadra 800 using the Operating Systems 7.1 and 7.1.1. In this event, it may be necessary to upgrade to an operating system higher than 7.1.1.

### ERROR OF TYPE 1

Check the required memory size. This can be done by clicking on the application icon then selecting *Get Info* from the *File* menu. Also check the QuickTime version. As a last resort, reset the P-RAM on the machine. This can be done by holding down the **<option>** key, the **<command>** (Open Apple) key, the **<R>** key, the **<P>** key and choosing *Restart* from the *Special* menu. Listen for 5 tones (they play slowly) and then release the keys to boot up the computer. This resets the P-RAM on the computer.

# ERROR OF TYPE 39

The application file has been corrupted and must be reinstalled. Remember, all saved games will be lost when the game is reinstalled. This can occur if you continue to attempt to play even when you are experiencing the problem where the game quits in a certain area. It can also be caused by not saving games correctly.

# NOT ENOUGH MEMORY

Disable any unnecessary extensions. This can be done using the Extensions Manager or by creating a disabled extensions folder.

# AFTER THE INSTALLATION OF GAME, MACHINE NO LONGER BOOTS UP PROPERLY.

Probably an incompatibility with Sound Manager, which should not be used on any of the AV systems. Reboot the computer while holding down the <shift> key (this will bypass the extensions), then drag the Sound Manager icon to the trash can and restart the computer. If Sound Manager is needed for game operation, remember to reload it.
