### **GETTING STARTED**

To use All My Hummingbirds Have Alibis,

- 1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Open the Subotnick Hummingbirds folder on your hard disk.
- 3. Double-click the All My Hummingbirds Have Alibis icon.

## **NAVIGATION**

The program has seven major parts. You can go to any of the parts by clicking on their names in the table of contents, or through the Hummingbirds menu in the menu bar. To show the menu bar, move the cursor to the top of the screen.

Throughout the program, the cursor changes depending on its screen location. What follows is an explanation of what happens when you click with the special cursors.



Returns to the main table of contents (near top of screen)



Pauses the audio (center of screen, or over musical examples)



Resumes the audio (center of screen, or over musical examples)



Pages backward and forward (left and right sides of screen)



From within the performance of All My Hummingbirds Have Alibis, brings up viewing options. You can view the collage images, the composer's commentary, or the score. (Bottom of screen)

## TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- · Any color-capable Macintosh
- A 13-inch (640×480) or larger color or grayscale monitor
- Macintosh system software 6.0.7 or later
- · At least 3,000K of available RAM
- · A Macintosh-compatible CD-ROM drive
- Headphones or external speakers required if CD-ROM drive is external; highly recommended if internal

Note: When using an external CD-ROM drive, most audio will play from the CD-ROM drive's audio-out port(s), and some will play from your Macintosh's internal speaker. You can use a Y-cable to play both sources through your headphones or external speakers, or use speakers specially designed for this purpose.

## Copying the Subotnick Hummingbirds Folder

Drag the Subotnick Hummingbirds folder to your hard drive to copy it.

# **Installing Fonts**

For the program to appear correctly on your screen, you must install the AllMy Fonts suitcase (in the Subotnick Hummingbirds folder) according to one of the following procedures:

#### IF YOU'RE USING SYSTEM 7...

Drag the AllMy Fonts suitcase to the System Folder icon on your hard drive and drop it. Your Macintosh will guide you through the rest of the font installation.

#### IF YOU'RE USING SYSTEM 6...

If you're using system software version 6.0.7 or 6.0.8, follow these steps to install fonts:

- 1. Double-click the AllMy Fonts suitcase. This will launch Font/DA Mover, which is part of your system software.
- 2. Click the Open button below the empty list box.
- 3. Select your System file.
- Select the fonts in the AllMy Fonts list box by holding down the shift key while you click.
- Make sure that the arrows on the Copy button are pointing to your System file.
- 6. Click Copy.
- Click Quit when you have finished installing the fonts. You must restart your Macintosh for the newly installed fonts to be available.

# **Adjusting Volume Levels**

This program uses CD audio—just like that of audio compact discs. You will enjoy it most if you use high-quality headphones or speakers. How to control the volume of the audio depends upon your Macintosh model and configuration. See your Macintosh or CD-ROM drive manufacturer's documentation for more information.
