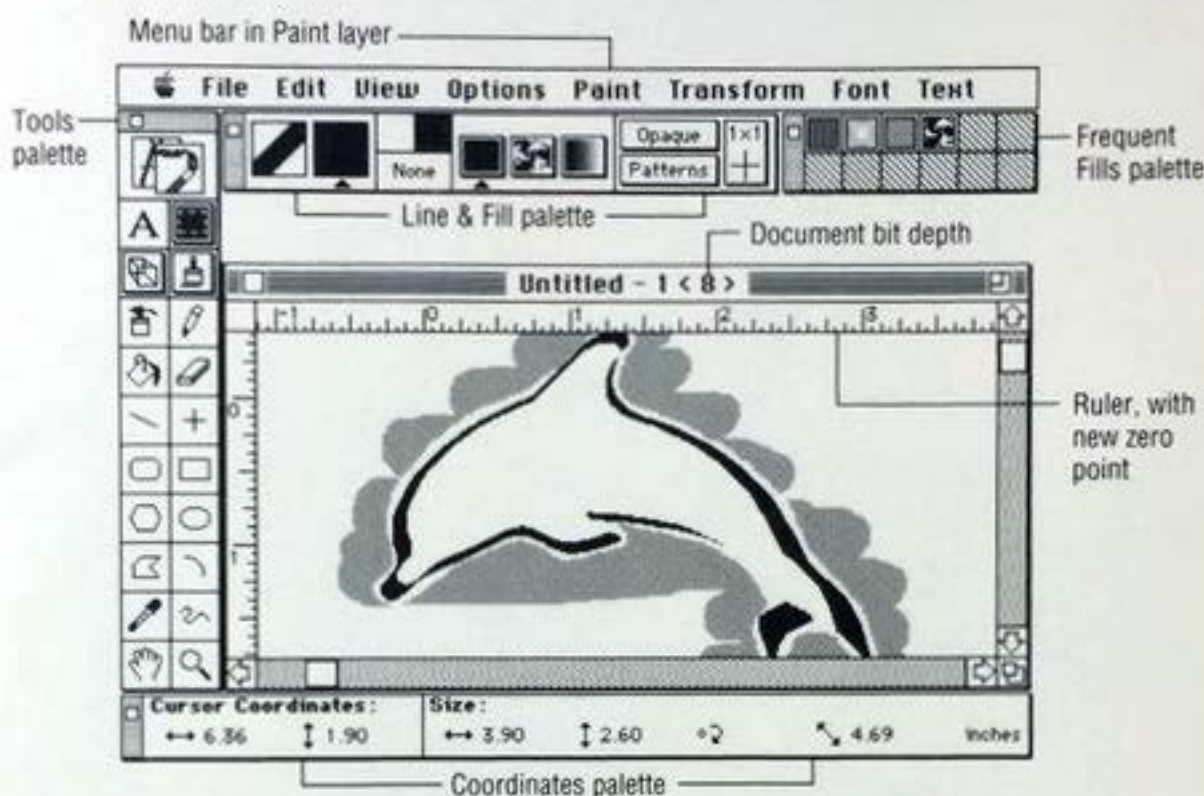


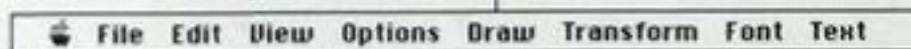

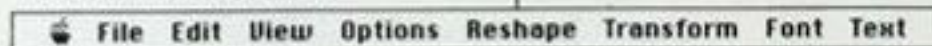
## Document Window



Menu bar in Draw layer



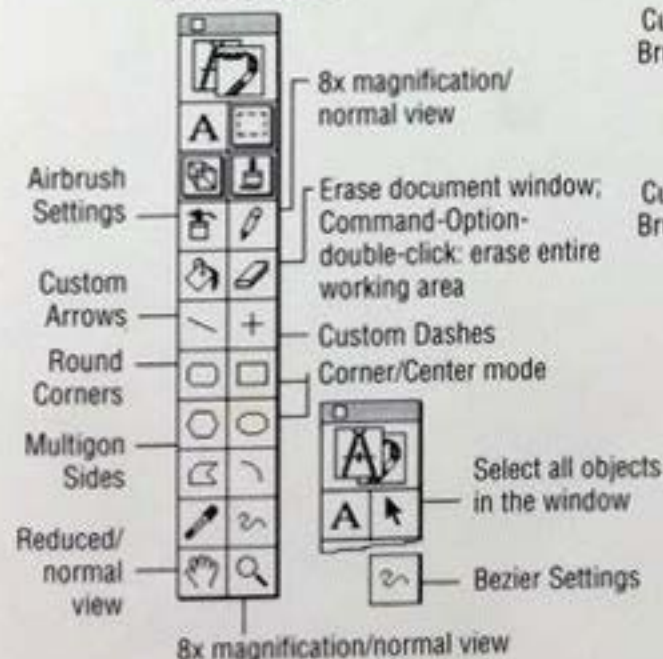
Menu bar in Reshape mode



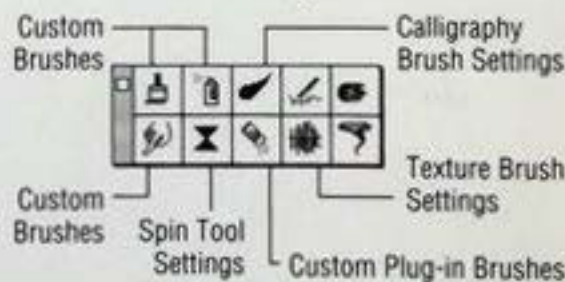

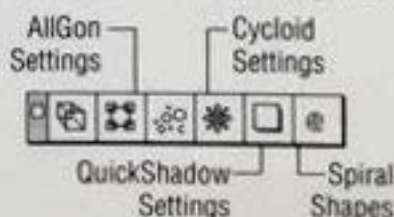

## Line & Fill Palette Shortcuts

### Colors palette

Double-click one of the color cells to display the Custom Color Table dialog box in 8-, 16-, and 32-bit documents.

### Continuous Color palette

Double-click the color bar on the left side of the palette to display the Apple Color Picker.

### Gradients palette

Double-click one of the gradient bars in the palette to display the Custom Gradients dialog box in 8-, 16-, and 32-bit documents.

### Patterns palette

Double-click one of the pattern cells to display the Custom Patterns dialog box.

### Textures palette

Double-click one of the Texture cells to display the Texture Info dialog box.

## Fills

In both layers, either a color, texture, or gradient can be assigned to the black areas of a pattern of the Line Fill or Area Fill. A color can be assigned to the white areas of the pattern.

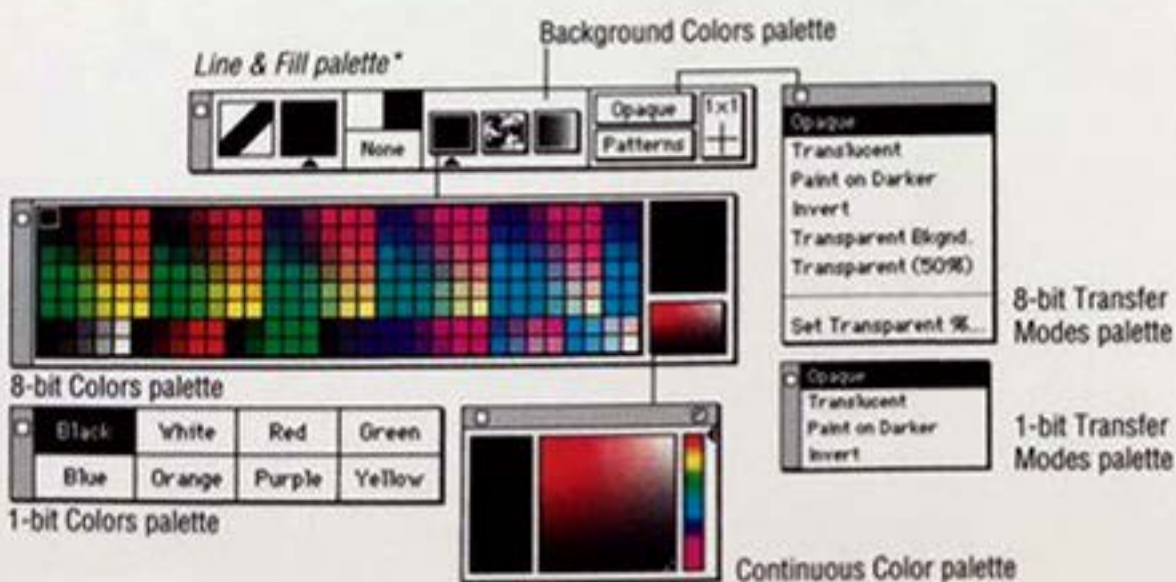
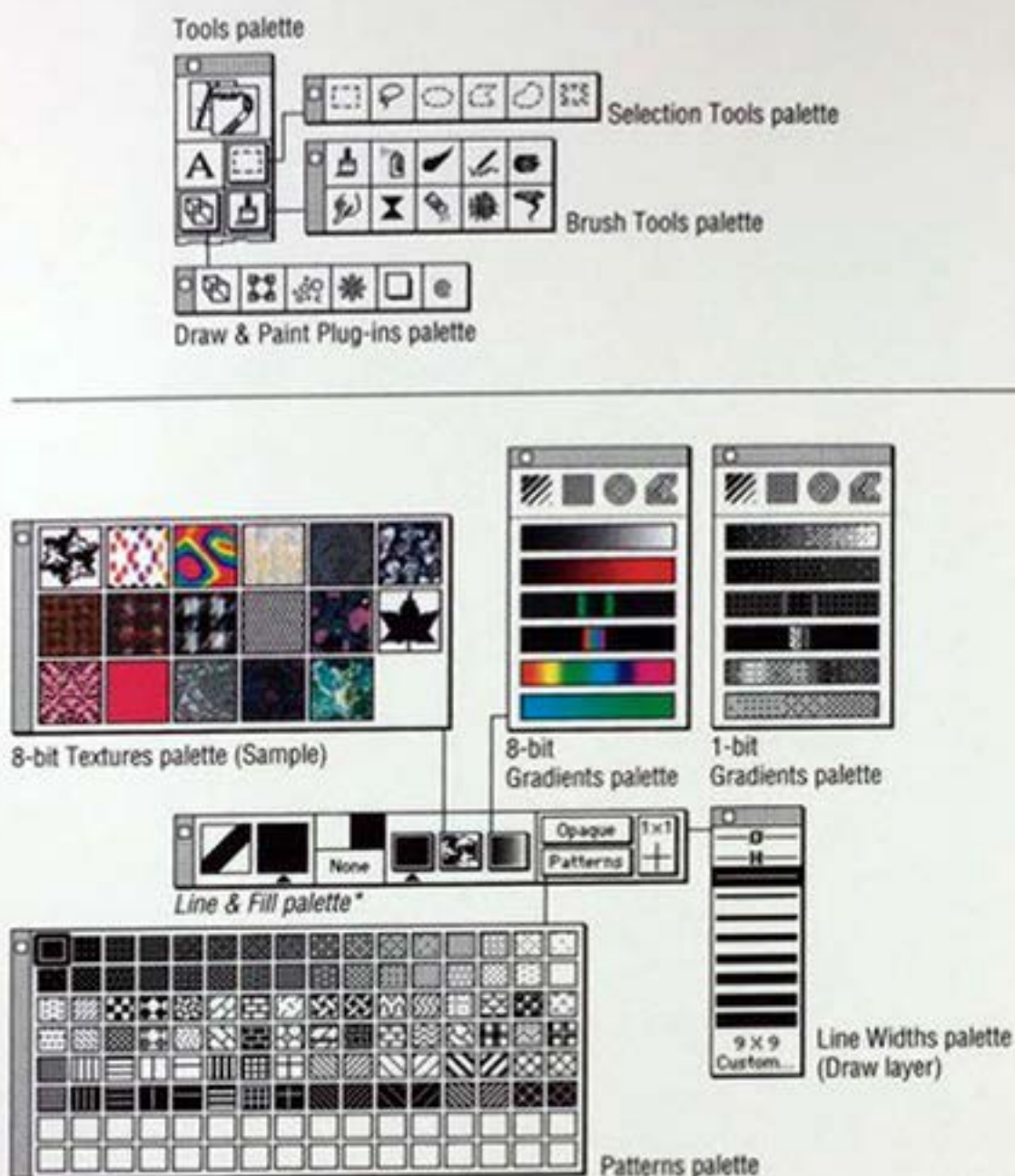

## Pop-up and Floating Palettes

Position pointer on a drop-shadowed box, press the mouse button to open the palette, and drag to make a selection. Some pop-up palettes change when plug-in modules are added to or removed from the SP Pouch.










# Menu Shortcuts

## Bezier Editing

Note: Bezier editing takes place in Reshape mode.

To:	Action:	Result:
Add a point to a curve	 Option-click	
Delete a point from the curve	 Select the point(s) and press Delete or Backspace	
Delete a segment	 Select segment and press delete	
Change Anchor Point (Hinge/Smooth)	 Double-click the point	
Change Segment Type (Straight/Curved)	 Double-click the segment	
Select a range of points	 Select the first point and Shift-click the last point	
Select or deselect a point for a selected range	 Command-click the point	

## Hot-Key Shortcuts

Hot keys switch to a different tool or display a palette as long as the key is pressed. When the Text tool is selected or the Caps Lock key engaged, the hot keys are inoperable (except the space bar).

**W** Line Widths palette

**E** Magnifier—Enlarge

**R** Magnifier—Reduce

**T** Tools palette

**A** Selection Arrow (Draw layer only)

**S** Selection Tools palette (Paint layer only)
